Communicate with community through videoconference	Organizer provides periodical live-stand-ups with remote sites in the space bridge way. The communication will be organized through one of popular webinar platforms (like Cisco Webex)	A room which will be available for visitors during the forum on May 26 and 27 Video connection requires up to 1 Mbps of network channels bandwidth A web-camera, speakers and a directional microphone are required for those, who would like to participate in the space bridge with the main PHDays site in Moscow

Depending on the number of rooms and beamers, network channels bandwidth and other characteristics you will be able to determine the conditions on the site and capabilities that will be provided for the visitors of your site. When your plans for event organization are decided, we will ask you to share with us this information (name, description, logos, links, and contacts), so we could publish it on our web site and attract more visitors to your event.
